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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

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**AN ACT to Prohibit Certain Uses of Herbicide.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 1471-D, sub-§ 9, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 397, § 2, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

**No license or certification may be granted to any such employee or official engaged in highway or right-of-way maintenance if spraying will be the method of application.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits the roadside spraying of pesticides for highway or right-of-way maintenance by State, county or municipal officials or employees.
