COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1002, L.D. 1199, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Tuition Reimbursement to Private Schools."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the amending
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'This amount shall be defined as the insured value factor and it
shall not exceed \$75 7.5% of a school's legal tuition rate per
pupil in any one year.

Fiscal Note

The bill as amended will cost local units \$200,000 for the
next 2 years. In the 3rd year, the costs will be part of the state
and local allocation formula and the state's share will be \$100,000.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the legal tuition rates of the bill
from 15% to 7.5% and adds a fiscal note.
