SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 998, L.D. 1221, Bill,
"AN ACT to Simplify the Requirements for the Granting of
Permission to Additional Institutions to Use Established
Satellite Facilities."


Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out everything
after the amending clause and inserting in its place the
following:

' 37. Service corporation. "Service corporation" means
a corporation substantially all the activities of which con-
sist of originating, purchasing, selling and servicing loans
and participation interests therein; or clerical, bookkeeping,
accounting and statistical or similar functions related to
a financial institution or real estate activities; or manage-
ment, personnel, marketing or investment counseling related
to a financial institution or real estate activities; or
establishing or operating one or more satellite facilities.'
