STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Make all Drivers' License Information Confidential.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 57, as amended by PL 1971, c. 360, § 6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§ 57. Public records; confidential records; complaints confidential

All records of the Secretary of State pertaining to the applications and registrations of vehicles shall be open to public inspection during office hours. All records of the Secretary of State pertaining to operators' licenses shall be confidential and shall not be disseminated. Complaints in writing may be regarded as confidential.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make all drivers' license information confidential.
