SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
S.P. 417, L.D. 1240, Bill, "AN ACT to Remove the Customer Charge  
from Electric Utility Rate Structures."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the title the  
following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency  
preamble.'

Further amend the Amendment  $\leftarrow$  at the  
beginning of the first line after the title by striking out  
the word "Amend" and inserting in its place the words 'Further  
amend'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§96."  
by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in its place  
the following:

'4. Residential customers engaged in agriculture. Any  
increase in the per kilowatt-hour charge resulting solely from this  
section does not apply to residential customers for agricultural  
purposes as defined in Title 36, section 2013, subsection 1,  
paragraph A.'


Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end before  
the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and clause.

This amendment also removes family farmers from the impact of this legislation in a simpler way than the original amendment does.
