COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 420, L.D. 1242, Bill "AN ACT Requiring an Annual Report on Safety Problems by Nuclear Power Plants."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§3341." and inserting in its place the following:

'§3341. Reporting

The operator of any nuclear electric power generating plant in the State shall report annually by April 1st to the Maine Bureau, State Library/with a copy sent to the Bureau of Civil Emergency Preparedness, on any unresolved safety problems at the plant. The report shall include a list and summary description of any safety-related incidents reported to the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission during the previous calendar year, including a statement of the cause of the incident, its effects on human health and the environment, corrective measures which have been taken and the costs.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment restricts the bill to require only reporting of safety-related incidents reported to the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission and deletes reporting of generic safety problems. It also deletes the penalty.
