STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide a \$500 Fine for Hunting Turkeys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 7901, sub-§ 5 is enacted to read:

5. Hunting turkey in violation of section 7456, subsection 3, is a Class E crime, except that a fine of \$500 shall be assessed, in addition to any term of imprisonment which may be assessed, for each violation. This fine may not be suspended.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is to provide for a mandatory \$500 fine for hunting turkeys.
