**AN ACT Requiring Disclosures of Hiring Policies for Public Schools.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 864 is enacted to read:

**§ 864. Posting of hiring policy**

**Upon the effective date of this section all public schools shall disclose any hiring policies they have adopted.**

**Hiring policies shall be reduced to writing so as to be made available to prospective applicants upon request.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to ensure that the hiring policy's of public schools be disclosed to prospective employees. Many schools have used policies of nepotism arbitrarily. This bill attempts to correct these inconsistencies.
