COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1093, L.D. 1290,
Bill, "AN ACT to Establish an R. B. Hall Day to Honor and
Commemorate a Great Maine Composer."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless
enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the purpose of this bill is to dedicate the last
Saturday in June in commemoration of R. B. Hall, a great Maine
composer; and

Whereas, the last Saturday in June of this year will pass
before the normal effective date of this Act; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in
the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds an emergency clause so that R. B. Hall Day can be celebrated this year.
