STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

**AN ACT to Establish an R. B. Hall Day to Honor and Commemorate a Great
Maine Composer.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1 MRSA § 119 is enacted to read:

§ 119. R. B. Hall Day

The last Saturday in June of each year shall be designated R. B. Hall Day and the Governor shall annually issue a proclamation inviting and urging the people of the State to observe the day with appropriate ceremony and activity. R. B. Hall Day shall commemorate and honor R. B. Hall, an internationally recognized composer. Recognized primarily as a composer of marches, he was an accomplished conductor and coronet soloist, whose creative talent and native ability marked him as one of Maine's outstanding citizens.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes an R. B. Hall Day as the last Saturday in June to honor one of Maine's greatest composers of march music.
