SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1100, L.D. 1297, Bill, "AN ACT for the Assessment of Watercraft."

Amend the Amendment in that part designated "§610-A." by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'By February 1, 1982, the State Tax Assessor shall by regulation prescribe a formula which may be used by municipalities as a guideline to determine the just value of watercraft, other than canoes, which exceed 12 feet in length but which do not exceed 65 feet in length. The formula shall take into consideration such factors as dimensions, construction materials, propulsion and depreciation factors, excluding outboard motors of 10.5 horsepower or less.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exclude canoes and outboard motors with less than 10.5 horsepower ← → from the State Tax Assessor's rule-making authority.
