HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 455, L.D. 1301, Bill, "AN ACT to Require Public Hearings Prior to Proposing Exchanges of Public Reserved Lands."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 30 MRSA §4169, sub-§1-A, next to last ¶, first sentence, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 495, §2, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §4169, sub-§1-B is enacted to read:

1-B. Notice for sales, exchanges and relocations. Prior to requesting approval under subsection 1 and review under subsection 1-A, the director shall give notice of the proposed sale, exchange or relocation and may hold a public hearing, provided that he shall hold a public hearing if requested by any party.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes the present public notice requirements for sales of small parcels of land apply to all sales, exchanges and relocations of public reserved lands.
