COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1112, L.D. 1317,
Resolution, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine

Amend the resolution in the 12th line after the title
(10th line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words
"two years" and inserting in their place the underlined words
'one year'

Further amend the resolution in the question by striking
out in the last line (same in L.D.) the figure and word "2 years"
and inserting in their place the following: 'one year'

This amendment changes from two to one the number of
years during which a signature is valid.
