COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 466, L.D. 1322, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Final Offer Arbitration for Collective Bargaining in the Potato Industry."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§1958-A." by striking out all of subsection 7.
