STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Assist Homeowners in Peak Power Conservation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

35 MRSA § 94, as last amended by PL 1979, c. 541, Pt. B, § 45, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The Public Utilities Commission shall mandate, in any electric utility rate schedule approved or taking affect after September 1, 1981, a reduced peak power conservation rate for any residential user who installs a load management device approved by the commission.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill would encourage energy conservation by providing reduced rates for those with approved loan management devices.
