SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
S.P. 475, L.D. 1358, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Department
of Environmental Protection to Provide Technical Assistance to
Municipalities and other Quasi-municipal Entities Regarding
Solid Waste Management."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of section 3
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
of this Act.
