COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 475, L.D. 1358, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to Provide Technical Assistance to Municipalities and other Quasi-municipal Entities Regarding Solid Waste Management."

Amend the bill in section 1, subsection 6, by adding at the end the following underlined sentence: 'This subsection is repealed on June 30, 1983.'

Further amend the bill in section 2, 3rd line, (2nd line in LD) by striking out the word "committee" and inserting in its place 'Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources'

Further amend the bill by striking out section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Expiration date. The provisions of this Act shall expire June 30, 1983, unless its provisions are reenacted by the ~~first~~ regular ~~session~~ of the 111th Legislature.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

'Fiscal Note

The resources for carrying out the objectives of this Act and those administrative responsibilities in L.D. 949 are included in the Part II budget for the Department of Environmental Protection. \$175,000 is requested for fiscal year 1982 and \$160,550 is requested for fiscal year 1983.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment specifies the legislative committee to review the technical assistance programs, corrects the effective date of the bill and changes the fiscal note.
