COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1152, L.D. 1373, Bill,
 "AN ACT Relating to the Transport of State Prisoners in
 Knox County."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
 first line after the enacting clause the underlined
 abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by adding at the end before the
 Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are
 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
 of this Act.

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds an appropriation necessary to cover
 the costs of transfer of prisoners within Knox County. In 1980,
 the county transported 60 state prisoners.

The costs are less for the first year since the State
 will not be incurring the cost until October.
