STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Transport of State Prisoners in Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

34 MRSA § 751-A is enacted to read:

§ 751-A. Costs of transfer of state prisoners to Knox County

The State shall pay the costs of transporting and guarding prisoners during their transport from the Maine State Prison to the Knox County jail or court house.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require the State to assume responsibility for the costs of transferring a prisoner from the Maine State Prison to the Knox County jail or court house.
