STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide for Identifying Natural, Nonimitation Food Products sold in the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 7 MRSA § 552, sub-§ 4 is enacted to read:
- 4. Symbol. The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources may select an appropriate symbol to designate a food found by the department to be a natural food. A person wishing to be permitted to use the symbol must first satisfy the department that the food is natural in compliance with this subchapter. The department may establish a fee for the use of the symbol.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to establish, and charge a fee for the use of, a natural food symbol. This will help consumers identify foods which are natural according to the statutory standards.
