COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1161, L.D. 1393, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Property Tax Laws."

Amend the Bill in the first line after the enacting
clause (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined
abbreviation and figure "Sec. 1."

Further ~~Amend~~ the Bill by striking out all of sections 2
and 3.

Statement of Fact

This amendment eliminates an increase in compensation
of certain members of the Land Classification Appeals Board
and a mandate that the State Tax Assessor establish a training
program for tax assessors. The bill, as amended, requires no
fiscal note because the State Tax Assessor estimates no
additional cost to offer qualifying exams 4 times each year.
