COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1190, L.D. 1414, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Seeking Work and Accepting Suitable Work
to be Eligible for Extended Unemployment Benefits."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the 4th paragraph
and inserting in its place the following:

'Whereas, new federal conformity requirements mandate state
implementation of these measures effective the first week after
March 31, 1981; and'

Further amend the Bill by striking all of the emergency
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment revises the emergency preamble and emergency
clause to reflect new action by Congress, requiring immediate
implementation of the measures contained in the bill.
