COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 505, L.D. 1432, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Legislative Review of Agency Rules."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §8053, sub-§1, ¶E is enacted to read:

the

E. All members of /joint standing committee of the Legislature

with jurisdiction to hear proposed legislation affecting the

statutory authority under which the proposed rule is to be

promulgated. Each cochairperson of a joint standing committee

notified under this paragraph, or the cochairperson's designee,

who attends a public hearing on a proposed rule for which the

cochairperson has received such notice is entitled to reimburse
ment for actual expenses incurred in attending the hearing;

that

provided/ the hearing was held on a day that the /egislature

was not in session.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

#### 'FISCAL NOTE

This bill will result in additional cost as it relates to a member of a joint standing committee, attending a public hearing on a proposed rule while the Legislature is not in session, being reimbursed for actual expenses.

No estimate is available because it is not known how many may be involved.

### Statement of Fact

#### This amendment:

- 1. Requires an agency that is proposing to adopt a rule to notify all members of the joint standing committee with jurisdiction to hear proposed legislation affecting the statutory authority under which the proposed rule is to be promulgated; and
- 2. Authorizes the cochairpersons of a committee so notified, or their designee, to receive reimbursement for actual expenses incurred in attending such a hearing when the Legislature is not in session.
