HOUSE AMENDMENT "^A" to H.P. 1216, L.D. 1445, Bill,
"AN ACT to Authorize a Self-liquidating Bond Issue for Kenne-
bec County for the Construction of a New Detention Facility."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 4 the
following:

'Sec. 4-A. State to sell land. The Director of the
Bureau of Public Lands shall convey to the County of
Kennebec a parcel of land in Augusta ^{as} provided in this
section. The county commissioners of Kennebec County
may select a parcel, not to exceed 8 acres, from the parcel
on exhibit A that abuts Hospital Street and is a rectangle
of 750 feet by 525 feet as marked on exhibit A. The parcel
shall be conveyed for its fair market value, not to exceed
\$5,000 per acre, as determined by the Director. The parcel
shall be used only for a county detention facility and shall
revert to the State if used for another purpose.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the state-
ment of fact the following Exhibit A.

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands to convey, not to exceed 8 acres of land, owned by the State in Augusta, at the option of the county commissioners, for a fair market value not to exceed \$5,000 per acre, to be used only for a county detention facility.
