STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Establish the Municipal Cost Components for Services to be Rendered in Fiscal Year 1981-82.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, prompt determination and certification of the municipal cost components in the Unorganized Territory Tax District is necessary to the establishment of a mill rate and the levy of the Unorganized Territory Educational and Services Tax; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Municipal cost components for services rendered. In accordance with the Revised Statutes, Title 36, chapter 115, the Legislature determines that the municipal cost component for services and reimbursements to be rendered in fiscal year 1981-82 is \$7,159,131 broken down according to the following list:

Forest fire protection	\$2,514,380
Maine Land Use Regulation Commission	333,351
Secretary of State	2,400
Property tax assessment	312,112
County reimbursement for services	1,400,000
Education	2,386,888
Human Services — general assistance	210,000

Total	\$7,159,131

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
