SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 1271, L.D. 1486, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Bail Commissioners.

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last 5 lines
before the Statement of Fact and inserting in their place the
following:

'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §2601, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. Review of bail commissioner procedures. The review of
bail commissioner procedures contained in Title 15, section 942,
subsection 1 and 1-A, shall be reviewed by January 1, 1983.

Sec. 2. 15 MRSA §942, sub-§1, first ¶, as enacted by
PL 1973, c. 760, is amended by adding after the first sentence
a new sentence to read:


The official having custody of the accused shall promptly
notify a judge or bail commissioner.'

Further amend the Amendment by renumbering sections 2 to 4
to be sections 3 to 5.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a review
of this legislation by January 1, 1983 and a report made
evaluating the advisability of the provisions being retained.
