COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1306, L.D. 1511, Bill,
"AN ACT to Create a Board of Review of the Judiciary."

Amend the bill by striking out the title and inserting
in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Provide the Appointment by the Governor of 3
Public Members to the Committee on Judicial Responsibility and
Disability.'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything
after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the
following:

'4 MRSA §9-B, as amended by PL 1979, c. 490, §1, is amended
by adding after the first ~~sentence~~ a new sentence to read:
Any committee established by the Supreme Judicial Court for
this purpose shall have at least 3 members, appointed by the
Governor, who shall represent the general public of the State
and shall not be attorneys or members of the
Judiciary.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment replaces the original bill and ensures that
any committee established by the Supreme Judicial Court concern-
ing judicial responsibility and disability will have at least 3
public members who shall be appointed by the Governor. The
Committee on Judicial Responsibility and Disability currently
has 3 public members.
