RESOLVE, Reimbursing the Town of Madison under the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law.

Reimbursement to be paid to the Town of Madison. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$5,093.11 to reimburse the Town of Madison for taxes lost by reason of forest lands being classified under the provisions of the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law pursuant to the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 578, subsection 1.
