IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Transfer of Certain Lands in Webster Plantation to the Heirs of Horace White.

Heirs of Horace White; land deeded to. Resolved: That the Director of Public Lands be authorized to convey to the heirs of Horace White all interest of the State in a parcel of land located in Webster Plantation, Penobscot County, consisting of 50 to 75 acres and being a portion of the Webster Plantation Public Lot.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the Director of Public Lands to convey any interest in a parcel of land in Webster Plantation claimed by the heirs of Horace White. This parcel was apparently left out of a resolve passed in 1963, Resolves 1963, chapter 38, of which intended to clarify all settlers claims in Webster Plantation.
