SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1508, L.D. 1622, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Salaries of Certain County Officers."

Amend the Bill by inserting after the title the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it has become necessary to revise the salaries of certain county officials; and

Whereas, these revisions are vitally necessary at the earliest possible time this law can become effective; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 8 and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved and shall be applied retroactive to January 1, 1981.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
