STATE OF MAINE (Filing No. S-289)

SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 1528, L.D. 1641, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$2,500,000 to Assist Municipalities with Resource Recovery of Solid Waste."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the Fiscal Note the following:

'Sec. 3. Retroactive reimbursement. Solid waste resource recovery or resource conservation projects, undertaken or contracted for since July 1, 1981, may be considered reimbursable under this Act.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment will make projects contracted for or constructed since July 1, 1981 eligible for reimbursement. This amentment will allow towns to / implement resource recovery projects pending the outcome of the referendum to ratify the bond issue.
