

SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 638, L.D. 1653, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Encourage Small Power Facilities."

Amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designated  
"§2324." in the 5th line from the end (4th line from the end  
in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "property"  
the underlined words 'for retail ratemaking purposes'

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows the Public Utilities Commission to  
require that avoided cost profits be returned to the ratepayers,  
but does not require that the utility investments in cogenerators  
as small power producers have prior approval. Such prior  
approval is not required under PURPA.
