SENATE AMENDMENT " E " to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 649,  
L.D. 1677, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and  
Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the amendment by striking out the first 3 lines  
and inserting in their place the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause  
the following:

PART A

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 42  
the following:

Sec. 42-A. Effective date. Section 42 takes effect 90  
days after the Legislature adjourns.'

Further amend the amendment by adding at the end before  
the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency  
clause and inserting in its place the following:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the  
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved, except  
as otherwise provided.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to coordinate the effective date of a correction in the bill with the effective date of Public Law 1981, chapter 165, which enacted the section being corrected. This amendment also clarifies the emergency clause.
