SENATE AMENDMENT "G" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 649,
L.D. 1677, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and
Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the state-
ment of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
emergency clause the following:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §8305, sub-§1, first sentence, as enacted
by PL 1981, c. 309, §3, is amended to read:
Persons providing home day care for 3 to 12/^{unrelated} children under the age of
16 unrelated to the provider on a regular basis shall be required to
register with the Department of Human Services.

Sec. 1-A. Effective date. The amendment to the Revised Statutes,
Title 22, section 8305, subsection 1, first sentence, contained in
Part B of this Act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of
the Legislature.'

Further amend Part B by renumbering the sections to read con-
secutively.

Statement of Fact

The amendment corrects an ambiguity which the Committee on Health
and Institutional Services did not intend, and makes clear that the
registration provisions apply to providers who are taking care of more
than 3 children who are not related to the provider.
