HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1707, L.D. 1699, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require State Bond Issues Passed at the First
Regular Session and the First Special Session of the 110th
Legislature to Include all Interest Involved for each Question
and to be Placed on the Ballot."

Amend the Bill by striking out in the last line before
the Emergency clause (same in L.D.) the underlined word and
punctuation "upon." and inserting in their place the following:
'upon, provided, that if the actual total debt service by the
bond indebtedness exceeds such estimate, the ratification by
the electors shall nevertheless be deemed conclusive, and the
validity of the bond issue shall not be affected by reason thereof.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the position
of the bonds should the actual total debt service exceed the
estimate provided on the ballot.
