9 10 11	Amend the bill in the first line after the enacting clause (first page, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the abbreviation and number "Sec. 1."
12 13 14	Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:
15 16 17 18	'3. Service. The professional employees of the Public Advocate shall serve during the pleasure of the Public Advocate; all other employees of the Public Advocate shall be subject to the Personnel Law.'
19 20	Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections $2 \ \mathrm{and} \ 3$.
21	STATEMENT OF FACT
22 23 24 25 26	This amendment assures that the professional staff of the Public Advocate serves at the pleasure of the Public Advocate, but drops from the bill further exemptions from the Personnel Law. Assistant attorneys general currently serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General.
27 28 29 30	It also drops the information requirements, sections 2 and 3, in view of good faith efforts by the utilities and the Public Utilities Commission to provide timely information to all concerned.
