## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 110TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

6 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 739, L.D. 1724, Bill, 7 "AN ACT to Adjust the Fees for Licenses Issued by the 8 Arborist Examining Board."

9 Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out everything 10 after the amending clause and inserting in its place the 11 following:

12 'Board members not of state agencies shall be paid daily 13 fees of \$20 \$25 per day involved, plus current state mileage 14 and living expenses incurred on those days.'

15 Further amend the Bill by striking out all of sections 16 5 and 6.

17 Further amend the Bill in section 8 by striking out 18 everything after the amending clause and inserting in its 19 place the following:

A \$25 fee shall accompany each application for examination and shall not be returnable. When an applicant is notified that he is eligible for a license following examination, he shall remit an additional \$20 to cover the biennial license fee of \$20 before a license is issued.

26 The fee for a biennial renewal license shall be \$20.'

27 Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sections con-28 secutively.

Fiscal Note

30 It is estimated that enactment of section 1 of this 31 bill will result in no substantial cost increase. It is 32 further estimated that enactment of section 6 will result in 33 an increase of \$1,000 in dedicated revenue.

## 1 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 739, L.D. 1724

STATEMENT OF FACT

3 This amendment increases the board members' per diem 4 from \$20 to \$25, not \$40 as proposed in the bill. It also 5 strikes those parts of the bill which would change the li-6 cense period from biennial to annual. Finally, it increases 7 the biennial license fee from \$10 to \$20, not \$30 as pro-8 posed in the bill.
