Be it en	ted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	<ol> <li>12 MRSA §542, sub-§8, as enacted by PL 1977 , is repealed.</li> </ol>
360, § 1	2. 12 MRSA §5012, as last amended by PL 1977, or is further amended by adding at the end a new to read:

The department may prepare and distribute printed and 1 2 audio-visual materials on matters within its statutory 3 iurisdiction. There is established within the department a 4 revolving fund for the use of the department to cover the 5 printing and distribution costs of these materials. The 6 commissioner shall fix the prices at which publications of the department may be sold or delivered. The department 7 shall retain, without charge, an appropriate number of each 8 publication for complimentary distribution. Income from the 9 sale of publications that were charged to the revolving fund 10 shall be credited to the revolving fund to be used as a con-11 tinuing carrying account to carry out the purposes of the 12 13 revolving funds.

14 Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §8002, sub-§2, ¶D, as enacted by PL 15 1979, c. 545, §3, is repealed.

16 Sec. 4. Transitional provisions. On the effective 17 date of this Act, funds remaining in the revolving funds 18 repealed by sections 1 and 3 shall be transferred to the revolving fund established by section 2. Moneys which would 19 have been credited to the repealed funds after the effective 20 date of this Act shall be credited to the revolving fund 21 22 established by section 2.

23 For 2 years following the effective date of this Act, the commissioner may credit to the revolving fund, estab-24 lished by section 2, income received from the sale of any 25 publication whose printing or distribution was funded by the 26 27 General Fund, provided that the income credited may be no 28 greater than the difference between the funds received from the sale of the publication and actual General Fund cost of 29 30 printing and distribution. tc

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## Statement of Fact

This bill repeals separate revolving funds in 2 bureaus of the Department of Conservation for printing and distribution of publications and creates a single revolving fund for this purpose for the entire department.
