22 **AN ACT to Provide for Withdrawal of Certain**  
23 **Lands from the Spruce Budworm Suppression Program.**  
24

25 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

26 12 MRSA §8424, sub-§3, last ¶, as repealed and replaced  
27 by PL 1981, c. 278, §5, is amended by adding at the end a  
28 new sentence to read:

29 Forest land which is eligible for inclusion within the spray  
30 project and which has been accepted by the director may be  
31 withdrawn from the spray program area prior to the end of  
32 the 5-year period if changes in present law, regulation or  
33 Maine Forest Service policy prohibit that forest land from

1 being treated with either biological or chemical sprays  
2 during the 5-year period.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 The director may withdraw any land accepted for the  
5 program prior to the end of the 5-year period if changes in  
6 present law, regulation or Maine Forest Service policy pro-  
7 hibit that land from being treated with either biological or  
8 chemical sprays during the 5-year period.
