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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "<sup>A</sup>" to H.P. 1753, L.D.1743, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Amend the Employment Security Law to Include  
Federal Requirements and Other Options Available to the  
State."

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Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 6-A in the  
16th line (page 3, line 35 in L. D.) by inserting after the  
underlined word "subsection" the following: '1 or'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to clarify a provision  
in the bill regarding the chargeability of individual  
employers' experience ratings for certain unemployment bene-  
fits. The Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 1193 relates  
to disqualification from benefits based on refusal to accept  
suitable work. This amendment adds a reference to the  
Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 1193, subsection 1,  
which relates to disqualification based on voluntarily quit-  
ting.
