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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 749, L.D. 1752, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Payment of School Committee Debts."

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Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause
the following:

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'Sec. 1. 20 MRSA §161, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1967,
c. 425, §19, is repealed and the following enacted in its
place:

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2. Auditor; vouchers to be approved. He shall issue
vouchers showing the correctness of bills contracted on ac-
count of school appropriations. A bill may not be allowed
for payment by:

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A. The municipal officers in an incorporated school
district, unless it has been approved in accordance
with section 853; or

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B. The treasurer of a school administrative district,
unless it has been approved by a majority vote of the
full membership of the board of directors or a finance
committee elected in accordance with section 306.'

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of
the first line after the enacting clause the abbreviation
and number 'Sec. 2.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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Title 20, section 161 specifies the powers of super-
intendents. This amendment makes their powers consistent
with the revision of the method of approving vouchers by
municipal school committees proposed in the original bill.
