17 AN ACT Concerning Payment of School  
18 Committee Debts.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 20 MRSA §853, 2nd sentence, as amended by PL 1967, c.  
22 425, §19, is repealed and the following enacted in its  
23 place:

24 No order may be drawn by the officers except upon presenta-  
25 tion of a properly avouched bill of items, the bill of items  
26 having first been approved by a majority of the members of  
27 the school committee or a finance committee of that school  
28 committee selected by them and certified by the superinten-  
29 dent of schools.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

Title 20, section 161, subsection 20, provides that the vouchers' bills may be approved by a finance committee of a School Administrative District. The finance committee could in fact be the chairman.

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
