8 9	Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:
10 11 12	'Sec. 1. 20 MRSA §1053, sub-§9, first ¶, as amended by PL 1979, c. 131, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
13	An administrative unit, which had been authorized by the
14	commissioner to postpone the establishment of a National
15	School Lunch Program, may apply to the commissioner for a
16	renewal of the postponement. The commissioner, with the
17	approval of the state board, may grant the requested post-
18	ponement provided that:
19	Sec. 2. 20 MRSA §1053, §9, as amended by PL 1979, c.
20	131, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph
21	to read:
22	If the postponement is granted for the conditions in para-
23	graph B, subparagraphs (1) and (2), it shall be for 3 years.
24	If the postponement is granted for the condition in para-
25	graph B, subparagraph (3), it shall be for 4 years.
26	STATEMENT OF FACT
27	This amendment extends the waiver period for establish-
28	ing a school lunch program from 3 to 4 years if its based on
29	lack of need.
