STATE OF MAINE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO
AN ACT to Establish a Uniform Hunting Season for Raccoons.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 12 MRSA §7467 is enacted to read:
<u>§7467. Raccoons</u>
Any open season for hunting raccoons established by the commissioner shall be of uniform duration throughout the State.
STATEMENT OF FACT
The purpose of this bill is to provide for a uniform hunting season on raccoons throughout the State. Presently, York County and part of Cumberland County are given 5 fewer hunting days than the rest of the State.
