18 **of Maine to Prevent Combining more than One Bond Issue**

21 **Constitutional amendment. RESOLVED:** Two-thirds of
22 each branch of the Legislature concurring, that the follow-
23 ing amendment to the Constitution of Maine be proposed:

24 **Constitution, Art. IX, §14-F is enacted to read:**

25 Section 14-F. Separate ratification of individual bond
26 issue projects. Whenever ratification by the electors of
27 the State is essential to the validity of bonds to be issued
28 on behalf of the State pursuant to Section 14, each indi-
29 vidual project to be financed by the issuance of those bonds
30 shall be submitted to the electors in a separate question.
31 Two or more projects may not be combined in a single ques-
32 tion for submission to the electors.
