18 **AN ACT to Restore a Property Tax Exemption**
19 **Previously Granted to the American Red Cross.**

21 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
22 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
23 unless enacted as emergencies; and

24 Whereas, the American National Red Cross is a benevo-
25 lent and charitable institution within the meaning of the
26 Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 652, subsection 1,
27 except that the American National Red Cross is not an insti-
28 tution incorporated by the State of Maine, having been
29 federally chartered by an Act of Congress; and

30 Whereas, one of the primary duties of the American
31 National Red Cross is to render services and financial aid
32 to the people of this State in times of distress and to fam-
33 ilies and personnel of the Armed Forces of the United States
34 stationed within the State of Maine; and

1 No change has been made in the language which was the law
2 until 1979.

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
