17 **AN ACT to Increase the Working Capital of the State**
18 **Liquor Commission.**

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 Sec. 1. 28 MRSA §56, 5th sentence, as repealed and
22 replaced by PL 1975, c. 741, §4 and as amended by PL 1975,
23 c. 771, §300, is further amended to read:

24 The maximum permanent working capital of the commission is
25 established at ~~\$3,500,000~~ \$5,000,000 and permanent advances
26 up to this amount may be authorized by the Governor upon
27 recommendation of the commission with the approval of the
28 Commissioner of Finance and Administration.
