19 20 21 22 23 24	This amendment establishes guidelines for providing parking spaces designated for vehicles of handicapped persons only. It also authorizes owners of private off-street parking to enter into agreements with local or county law enforcement agencies under which unauthorized vehicles using handicapped-only spaces would be tagged.
