agreements with the owners of private off-street parking facilities for the policing, when notified, of stalls and spaces dedicated for handicapped persons' vehicles, under which agreements unauthorized vehicles shall be towed at the owner's expense.

## Statement of Fact

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This bill permits municipalities to provide for parking spaces designated for vehicles of handicapped persons only. Unauthorized vehicles would be towed at the owner's expense. It also permits municipalities to enter into agreements with the owners of private off-street parking facilities, under which unauthorized vehicles would be towed from dedicated handicapped spaces.
