AN ACT Establishing a Directional Sign at Exit 8 of the Maine Turnpike Indicating St. Joseph's College.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23 MRSA §1201, sub-§34 is enacted to read:
34. St. Joseph's College. Such sign or signs shall be provided by St. Joseph's College and installed and maintained by the Maine Turnpike Authority at exit 8 and shall conform with standards established by the Maine Turnpike Authority, and shall be worded as follows:
FXIT FOR ST INSEPH'S COLLEGE
